

## **Miracle Baby Goes Home**

Jessyca Frazier was born January 17, weighing less than 11 ounces. Her chances of survival were small. But miracle baby Jessyka was discharged Tuesday from the Woman's Center at St. Luke's Baptist Hospital in San Antonio. Her prognosis is good, and she now weighs more than five pounds.

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) care has benefited from tremendous advances in recent years. At the NICU, staff work with physicians to create as "womblike" an atmosphere as possible, so that premature infants develop in an environment as close to possible as their mother's womb. This greatly improves their chances of developing more normally. Jessyka's mother says she is glad to finally get her baby home.
