Presentation Content

Presentations should include the following content based on the type of project/study. Please see additional resources on the [conference website](#) in the Oral and Poster Presenters section.

EBP project presentation content should include:

- Purpose and rationale clearly stated
- Model used
- Synthesis of evidence
- Practice change
- Implementation strategies used to promote adoption and sustain the practice change
- Evaluation used; report baseline and post-pilot data from both process and outcome indicators
- Conclusions and implications for practice; summarize the project findings and implications for practice

Research study presentation content should include:

- Research question or aim clearly stated
- Background of the problem and current knowledge gap
- Methods describing the study including the sample, design, measures, and analyses
- Results showing description and findings
- Conclusions and implications for practice; summarize the study results and implications for practice

Synthesis report presentation content should include:

- Description of clinical topic
- Representation of experts on the team, management of conflict of interest, and process for peer review
- Methods described for finding and assessing individual studies as well as synthesis method
- Findings; specific practice recommendations and strength of each recommendation using an established system
- Conclusions and implications for practice; summarize the evidence and implications for practice
