The TRC's screen is divided into 3 sections:

The left panel for general browsing and navigation through the database.

The right panel where the topics are viewed.

A narrow panel at the bottom of the screen with buttons for closing the tree menu, navigating forwards and backwards, displaying the current selected topic

Assess: Book with chapters, list of drugs, search

The TRC tree menu is made up of a list of chapters on different fields of medicine. These chapters contain submenus with more specific information. When a chapter contains a submenu, its title and icon will be preceded by a plus sign (+). You can open the submenu by either clicking the plus sign or the title ,revealing a branch of the tree menu. This will turn the plus sign into a minus sign (-) to indicate the submenu has been opened.


In general, each branch is built in the following order (although depending on the system or organ, some branches will differ):

  - → Pathophysiology
    - → Pathophysiology in detail (on cellular level)
      - → Mechanism of drug action
