

Using ClinicalTrials.gov to find research at the University of Iowa

- 1. Go to https://clinicaltrials.gov/
- 2. Under 'Find a Study' fill out your search parameters (this will help to limit the search to only studies conducted at the University of Iowa):
 - a. Condition or disease: Fill out the disease or medical condition that you are seeking to find research studies associated with
 - b. Other Terms: enter your doctor's name enter "The University of Iowa"
 - c. Country: United States then enter Iowa City, IA
 - d. Example:




- 3. Once your search results are up, limit the search using the filter on the left side of the screen, to only those studies that are "recruiting" or "enrolling by invitation".
 - a. Add any other filters that will help limit your search: i.e. Age range, biological sex
