

Volunteer Services Request for Funds Guidelines

Priority Funding Guidelines:

- Funds must directly benefit patient and/or families at UI Hospitals & Clinics and/or UI Stead Family Children's Hospital
- Requests that have a house-wide, positive impact on the patient/family experience are desired
- Requests that use a collaborative approach to reduce service fragmentation or duplication, enhance, streamline, or integrate services, or achieve better outcomes are desired
- Applications must be complete, including the appropriate signature(s), to be considered
- All else equal, special consideration is given to those areas utilizing volunteers
- Funds will not be granted for budgetary items such as routine equipment, either for staff support or patient care, research, or staff continuing education
- Funds should be requested only when appropriate sources for funding are not available or are not sufficient to fully fund a project
- Partial or full funding may be requested

2024-25 Request for Funds Applications are accepted now through January 21. Requests will be reviewed in January by the Contributions & Donations Committee and final funding approvals announced after the Volunteer Services Advisory Board Meeting the end of February.

<u>Review Process</u>: Funds requests are reviewed by the Contributions & Donations Committee, chaired by the Volunteer Services Advisory Board Chair and including the VSAB Chair-elect and Immediate Past Chair. The Director of Volunteer Services and a Nursing Administration representative serve as ad hoc members. Following careful review, the committee makes funding recommendations to the Volunteer Services Advisory Board, who then give final funding approvals.
