4. This bone is also known as your "shoulder bone."
5. This bone is also know as your "collarbone."
6. These bones make up your wrist. They connect your hand to the rest of your arm.
7. This is a long leg bone that extends from your hip to your knee.
8. This bone is also called your "kneecap."
9. This is a leg bone that is between your knee and ankle.
10. These bones are found in your feet and are also known as "ankle bones."
11. These bones are found in your hands and feet. In your hands they are commonly called "fingers." In your feet they are commonly called "toes."
