- _____ 6. These bones make up your wrist. They connect your hand to the rest of your arm.
- _____ 7. This is a long leg bone that extends from your hip to your knee.
- _____ 8. This bone is also called your “kneecap.”
- _____ 9. This is a leg bone that is between your knee and ankle.
- _____ 10. These bones are found in your feet and are also known as “ankle bones.”
- _____ 11. These bones are found in your hands and feet. In your hands they are commonly called “fingers.” In your feet they are commonly called “toes.”
