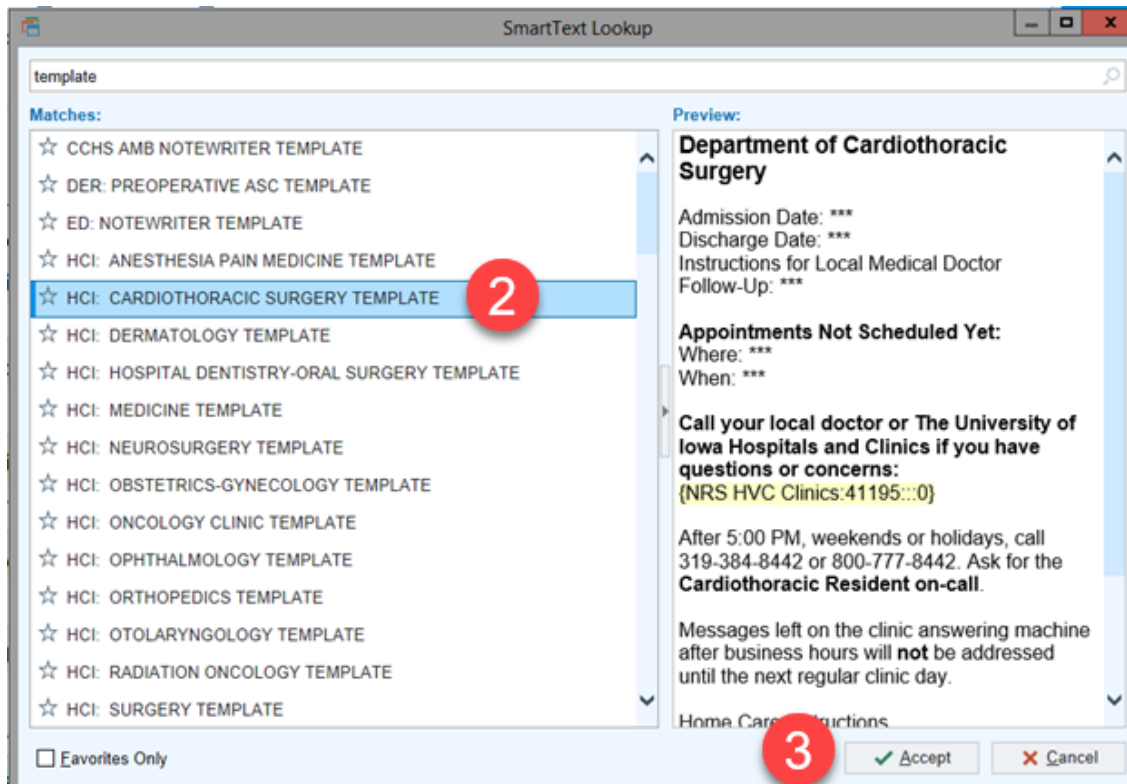
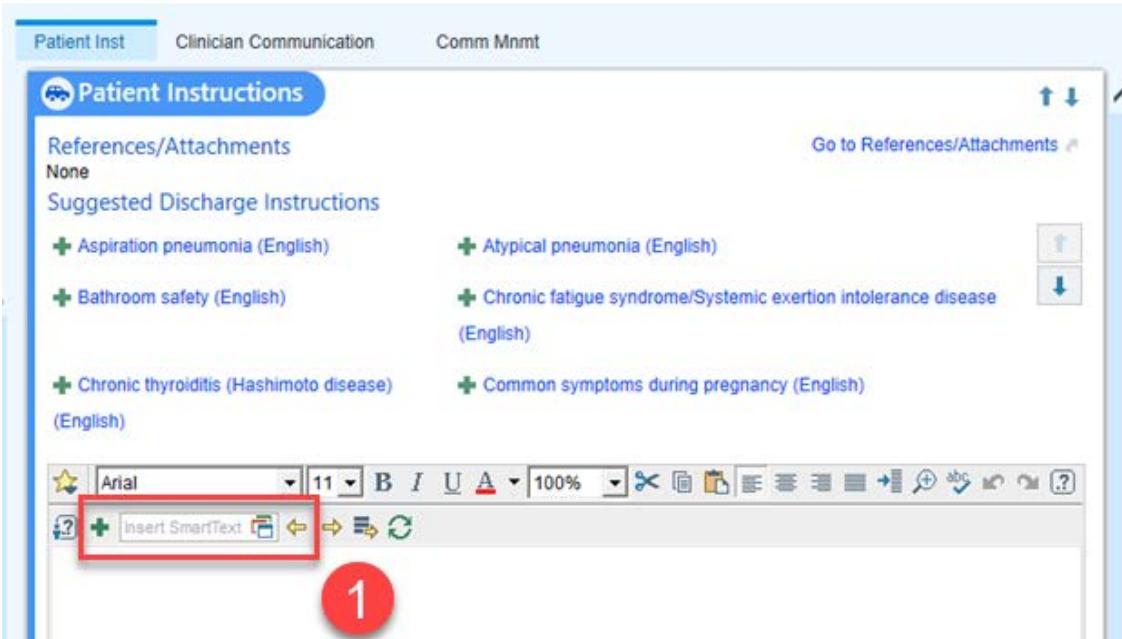


ADAM Search for Home Care Instructions

Ambulatory Patient Education | When instructions are not in the 'Suggested Discharge Instructions'

1. Search for "template"
2. Choose the template for the service you need
3. Add the template by clicking Accept





4. Click "Go to References/Attachments"
5. Search for desired topic
6. Review the document and click the "Attach Preview Document" box
7. The topic will appear under "References/Attachments"
