Infusion Scheduling

The Pediatric Cancer and Blood Disorder Center has gotten busier. For this reason, the scheduling in the clinic is changing.

Right now, most infusions are scheduled in the morning. The busiest time is mid-morning, 8:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

Your care team's top priority is giving safe and timely care. To be sure this happens, a few changes are being made:

- The schedule will have staggered start times.
 - This means patients will not check in all at the same time.
 - For example, 1 patient will check in at 8:00 a.m. and another patient will check in at 8:30 a.m. instead of 2 patients checking in at 8:00.
- The number of children checking in at 1 time will be lower.
- There will be more afternoon appointments for short infusions.

This will help lower long wait times. This will also make sure that your care team can do all safety checks for your infusion.

These changes may cause your normal appointment time to change. Please check your appointment times in MyChart before coming. For everyone's safety, please come on time.
